CosmicSky, is a critically acclaimed roving domed theatre exhibition that fuses astronomy with poetry, philosophy, sound and the visual arts to provide visitors with an immersive and uniquely ambient and educational experience.

Funded with a grant from NESTA (National Endowment for Science, Technology and the Arts), *CosmicSky* strives to offer a fresh and innovative approach to learning about the universe, and our very special place in it.

CosmicSky has successfully piloted at large-scale public venues across the UK. Over **10,000** people have now visited the CosmicSky Theatre.

Venues include Perth Concert Hall (Scotland's new centre for new media arts) and Bolsover Castle (English Heritage). Some venues located in areas of regeneration and revitalisation include Birmingham's Think Tank Science Centre, Gallery Oldham (which forms part of the new dynamic Cultural Quarter development in Oldham),

INSTALLATION

The Team of *CosmicSky* employ good project management practices and a professional approach. They efficiently set up the exhibition with minimum disruption to the venue. The Team provide training to venue staff enabling them to handle immersive environments and to help visitors engage fully with the exhibition. They also provide safety rules to ensure visitors enjoy the show in a safe environment.

Evaluation surveys are conducted and the information shared with the venue management.
